THE CHILDREN'S GUILD FOUNDATION'S SUMMER ATHLETES BOLD AT HEART PROGRAM

The Children's Guild Foundation's Summer Athletes Bold At Heart Program, the spring and summer component of SABAH's School Day programs, was back in force this year on the turf surface of the Cazenovia Rink. As a program that compounds the physical, social, behavioral, and academic benefits of SABAH's School Day programming, The Children's Guild Foundation's Summer Athletes Bold At Heart program incorporates movement with New York State Learning Standards and life skill development to improve outcomes for children with special needs.

What does SABAH's "off-season" look like? It might be better to ask, "Is there one?"
Because, while most everyone is aware of our Evening and Weekend adaptive ice skating season from October through March, SABAH offers seven programs that extend throughout the year.

Since our Celebration on Ice in March, we've been pretty busy!
Over the past few months,
SABAH athletes have been participating in SABAH's The Children's Guild Foundation's Summer Athletes Bold At Heart program, the Outdoor Series, Summer Skates, and the Adults Fit and Fun program.

SABAH'S OUTDOOR SERIES

SABAH's Outdoor Series offers birding, nature hikes, beach walks, snowshoeing, and other activities for SABAH athletes and their families/caregivers in New York State Parks. This spring and summer's Outdoor Series sessions included a thrilling boat ride in front of Niagara Falls on the Maid of the Mist, hiking in Letchworth State Park, and a trail walk in Niagara Falls State Park.



SUMMER SKATES

SABAH's 2023 Summer Skates offered an adaptive Ice skating program during the summer months for any individual, of any age, challenged by disability. The 2023 program had the largest number of participants in recent history and included six sessions at the Bud Bakewell Riverside Rink. These sessions emphasized building stamina and fitness, as well as increasing socialization during the summer months when many other programming options for individuals with special needs are on break.









SABAH's Adults Fit and Fun program offers adaptive recreation that meets the specific needs of individuals challenged by disability for any adult challenged by disability during the daytime hours of the work week. The program includes adaptive ice skating in the winter and sport court activities in the spring and summer

The spring/summer component of this year's Adults Fit and Fun program included adaptive ice skating, trail walks, basketball, soccer, yoga, and obstacle courses.
