

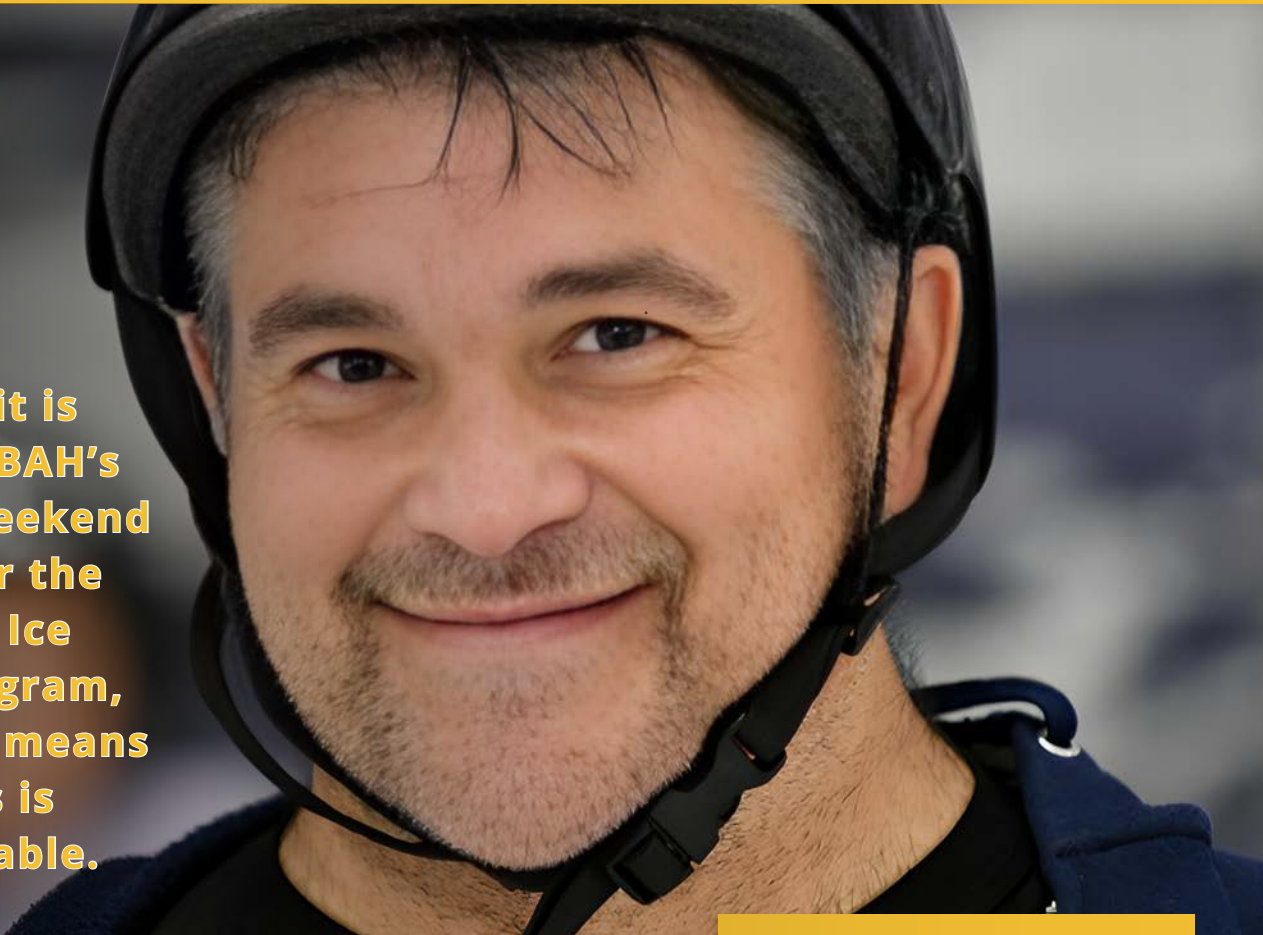

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHEILA O'BRIEN

This has been an extraordinary year. As our numbers continue to return to pre-pandemic levels, we have also enjoyed the opportunity to meet many new participants throughout the past year. 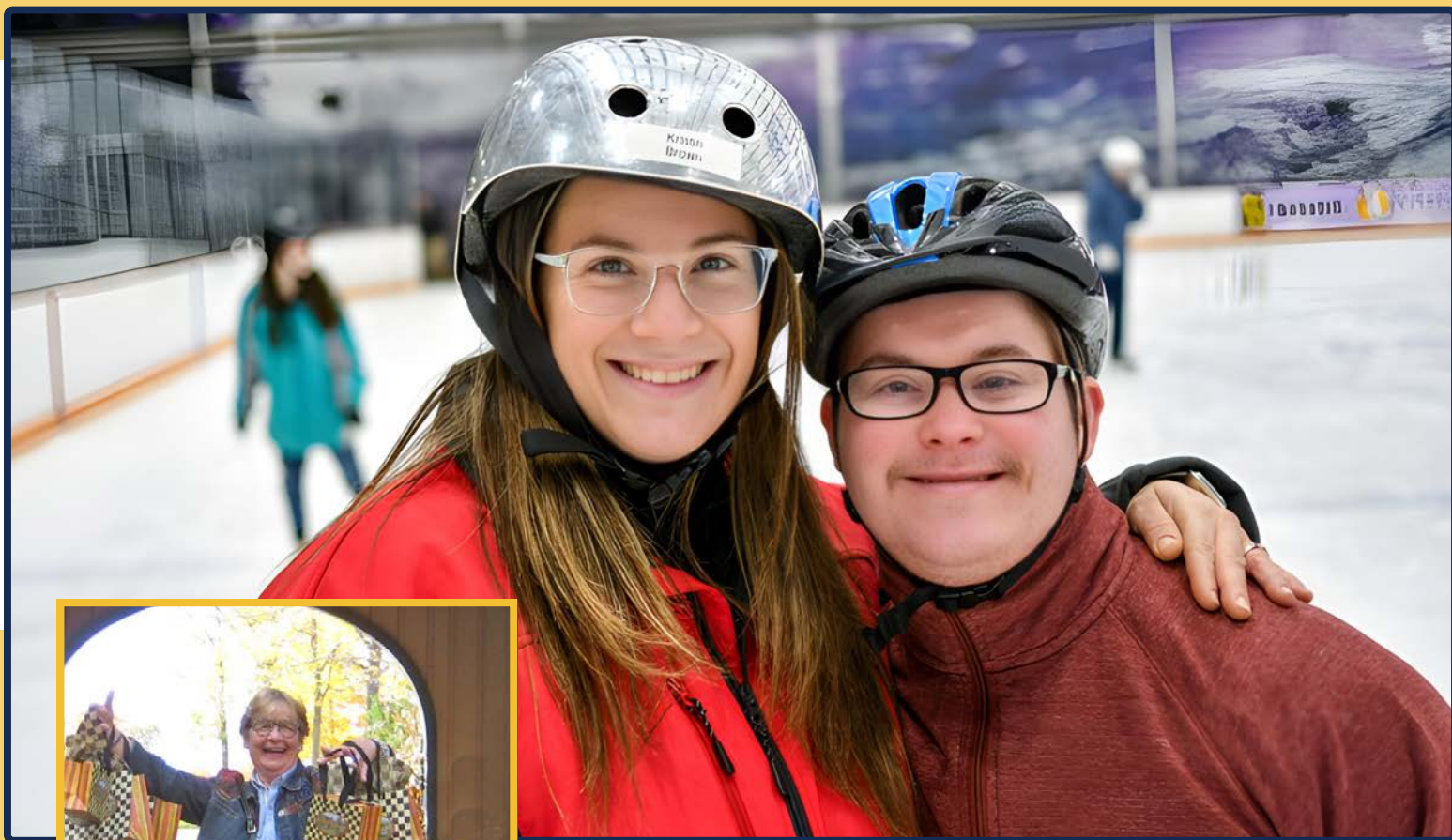

The Barbara Ann Willhoff Volunteer of the Year

The Barbara Ann Willhoff Award is named after one of SABAH's most beloved volunteers. Barbara Ann brought endless joy, encouragement, and confidence to both SABAH athletes and volunteers alike. This award serves as a lasting legacy to Barbara Ann, as well as an inspiration to all of us to love and serve each other in the same way she loved us.

Kristin is everything a volunteer should be... actually she's beyond that...she is the dream volunteer. She is, first and foremost, incredibly reliable. She's always there. If SABAH is on the schedule, Kristin is nearly guaranteed to be there to assist in some capacity. And, she will likely be there early to help set up or stay late to help clean up. At the end of an event, Kristin is typically the one who is walking out to the parking lot with the staff, as she is often the last one who stays to put equipment away or to clean up. Secondly, it's nearly impossible to label Kristin with a role, as she does just about anything for SABAH. Not only is she one of our most experienced on-ice volunteers at multiple locations and in multiple programs, but she also serves SABAH off the ice by offering her support for anything we need during our fundraising or special events; such as selling raffle tickets, checking in guests, taking photos, or shuttling gifts or equipment following an event.

Most importantly, Kristin adds tremendous joy to everything she touches. Our athletes, even the most reticent ones, instantly light up when Kristin is around. Our photo pages are filled with our athletes hugging her, dancing with her, smiling at her, and just wanting to be close to her. And, she has been a part of most of their lives for as long as they can remember, as she began volunteering with SABAH in 2006 and became an instructor shortly after in 2008.

Over and over again, Kristin reflects the joyful spirit of the award's namesake, Barbara Ann Willhoff. "The lasting legacy of Barbara was to love and serve each other the way she loved us," states SABAH's Executive Director Sheila O'Brien. "And, that's a nearly impossible standard to live up to, as Barbara had the most incredible way of making everyone feel so deeply loved and appreciated. But, Kristin fulfills that legacy. Like Barbara, she brings endless joy, encouragement, and confidence to both our athletes and volunteers, alike. She is the perfect honoree for this award." The Emily Hermance Spirit Award



SABAH's Emily Hermance Spirit Award is presented to the SABAH athlete who exhibits a spirit of enthusiasm and determination in spite of challenges. This special award honors one athlete who best exemplifies the courageous and optimistic spirit of the award's namesake.



Determination is deeply ingrained in the heart of SABAH athlete, Mikayla Forsey. Although blind, Mikayla is simply unstoppable. She is an artist, athlete, student, volunteer, friend, daughter, and more. Her talented artwork was recently featured on the cover of *Pathways Through the Dark*, an anthology that highlights artists impacted by visual impairments. In addition to skating with SABAH, she is also well known for her many other talents including piano, karate, Zumba, yoga, cooking, skiing, and beeper baseball.

MIKAYLA FORSEY

Mikayla is, without a doubt, an inspirational model of perseverance and optimism. She also happens to be genuinely kind and thoughtful to everyone around her. "Mikayla is both tender and fierce," states SABAH's Executive

Director Sheila O'Brien. "On the one hand, she is incredibly kind and soft-spoken. But then, there is also this overwhelming spirit of determination and fortitude that makes Mikayla completely unstoppable. There's nothing she can't do. And, she proves that over and over again. She is an inspiration to all of us."

She makes sure each of our athletes sets high goals and works to reach them."

Rosie has such great confidence in our athletes, that it inspires them to believe in themselves, as well. Over and over again, when Rosie works with a SABAH athlete, you can watch them make incredible progress. She's not content to let them stay where they are. When Rosie is working with an athlete, it's equal parts fun and business in the very best way.

She is the perfect example of the spirit of Gary George, Jr., as she demonstrates the quiet strength and compassion which made him a true unsung hero.
